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1 INTRODUCTION

The Department of Training and Technical Education, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, in its endeavor to provide skilled technical manpower suited to various needs of industry, imparts technical education and technological skill through various courses at different levels. Full-time degree/ diploma courses in Engineering /Technology / Pharmacy, Occupational and Secretarial / Management based disciplines are offered at different Government Institutions, Government aided Institutions & Privately managed Institutes.

G B Pant Institute of Technology, under the aegis of Department of Training & Technical Education, is offering admission for Advanced Diploma in Automotive Mechatronics (ADAM).

It is realized that, with the growing car market and technical complexities in Automobile technology as against the present level of education, it is imperative to provide an adequate number of qualified automotive engineers to support growing needs and fast changing technological advancements in automobile industry.

2 INTRODUCTION TO ADAM COURSE

Automotive Mechatronics Research Centre (AMRC), is a world class infrastructure, guided by Mercedes Benz India Limited (MBIL), Pune and has been developed at GBPIT, Delhi. Fully air-conditioned Classrooms, Car bay, Engine W/S, Transmission W/S, E- W/S and Telemetric & Microcontroller W/S are equipped with sophisticated digital instruments, IT / Computers diagnostic packages etc. The facility provides a comparable ambience to that of MBIL in-house facility. The entire facility is air-conditioned for smooth functionality of IT / Computers & Electronic gadgets in a dust-free temperature controlled environment and to achieve laboratory test results in European standards.

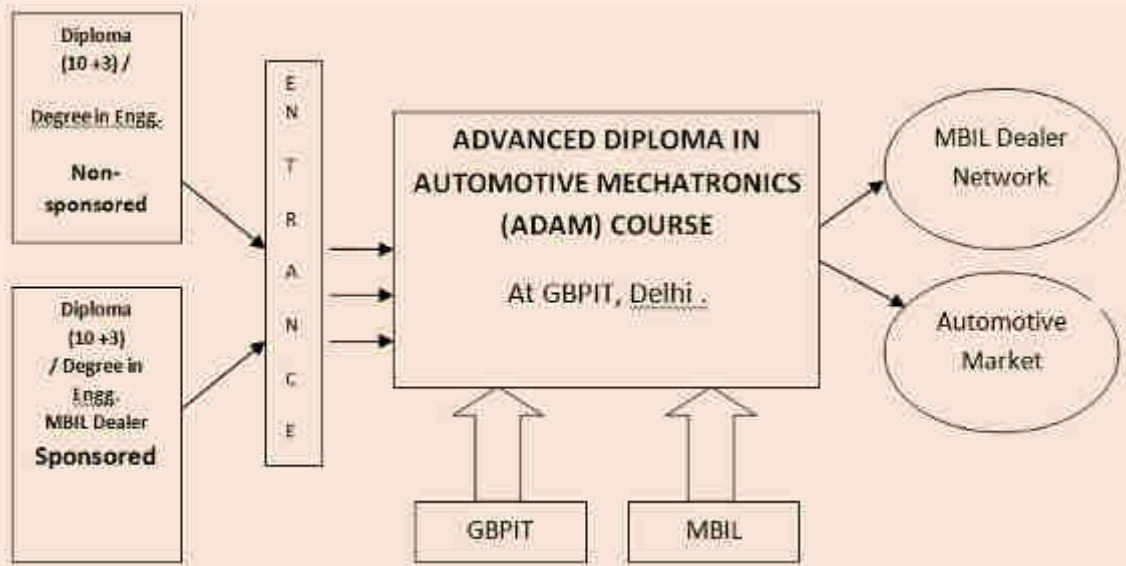
The highly specialized ADAM course will contain Electrical, Mechanical, Electronics / Embedded system, Vehicle Systems and Soft Skills modules. The training will be imparted in the areas of Electrical & Electronics Technology, Advanced Automobile Systems / Engineering and its diagnosis, practical hands on experience on MB Car, MBIL Factory visit (optional), etc.

The methodology will be self-reliant learning and team concept as being practiced successfully in MBIL. Trainer is facilitating the learning of the participant. Unlike the traditional classroom, learner is guided to solution and no readymade answers.

The intention of this collaborative course is to produce skilled automotive professionals conversant with latest automotive technology. ADAM is practical oriented course where learner is expected to have hands-on learning on the car, engines, transmission / gear box and other automotive components.

The ADAM Course shall be conducted in English language.

Programme in Principle



3 INTAKE CAPACITY AND ELIGIBILITY

The annual batch size / intake capacity is 20 students including five seats reserved for MBIL dealer nominees, sponsored and approved by MBIL.

The minimum eligibility of the candidates for seeking admission in ADAM is (i) a pass in 3 years diploma (2 years for lateral entry / direct second year) in Electrical / Mechanical / Electronics / Automobile Engineering, Mechatronics, Applied Electronics or equivalent.

(ii) a pass in Engineering Degree (B. Tech / BE) in Electrical / Mechanical / Electronics / Automobile Engineering, Mechatronics, Applied Electronics or equivalent.

(iii) those appeared for qualifying examination (B. Tech / BE / Diploma) in 2019, without live back papers, are also eligible to apply. However, their admission will be subjected to submission of proof of having acquired minimum qualification at the time of counselling.

4 INDUSTRIAL TRAINING

Provision of 4 to 12 weeks of industrial training / dealer in-house training has been kept as an integral part of the curriculum. The students shall be trained at dealership network in Delhi / NCR or anywhere in India, with the approval from MBIL / respective dealer.

5 PLACEMENT

G.B. Pant Institute of Technology has a well established Training and Placement Cell, which is headed by Training and Placement Officer. The Training and Placement Officer co-ordinates with the various Industries and arrange for campus interviews for all the branches. Most of the students with minimum 60% marks without backlog get placement even before the declaration of the final results. The Directorate of Training and Technical Education, Delhi also conducts Job Fairs every year.

6 ADAM ADMISSION ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (AAEE)

Admission to ADAM course will be through All India ADAM Admission Entrance Examination (A A E E). G B Pant Institute of Technology shall be functioning as nodal agency as well as the main examination centre for conducting All India ADAM Admission Entrance Examination (A A E E). The AAEE Examination is to be **held in Delhi**. However, examination centres other than Delhi may be considered, if required. The same will be made available on <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in> web portal.

Final allotment of examination centre to a candidate will be decided by G B Pant Institute of Technology / AMRC. Request for change of examination centre will not be entertained on any account.

7 FEE

a. Examination Fee:

Examination fee for AAEE is Rs 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) for General, OBC & sponsored candidates and Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred & Fifty Only) for SC/ST applicants.

The examination fee is US \$10 for other than Indian nationals.

The examination fee is to be paid online to Automotive Mechatronics Research Centre-AMRC account number: 37652460699 IFSC: SBIN0000727. The banking charges, as applicable, to be borne by the candidate.

The online fee once paid or multiple payments made will not be refunded (full or partial), under any circumstances. **The last date for payment of examination fee online to AMRC account is 08-06-2019.**

b. Course Fee / Fees Payable at the Time of Admission

The ADAM course fee is Rs. 95,000/- (Rupees Ninety Five Thousands Only) INR and is to be paid online at the time of counselling / admission. US \$1400 for international candidates. The banking charges, as applicable, shall be borne by the candidates.

8 SCHOLARSHIP

Mercedes-Benz India offers scholarship to one female candidate and two economically backward candidates who secure admission to the course fulfilling eligibility criteria and other conditions laid down by MBIL.

This year, it is under consideration by Mercedes-Benz India to offer Scholarship to All female candidates securing admission to ADAM course. However, confirmation in this regard is yet to be received from MBIL.

a. Structure of Scholarship:

The Scholarship amount per student shall be Rs. 1, 50,000/-. This amount is towards:

1. ADAM Course Fees
2. Hostel Accommodation Charges (Annual)
3. Other Expenses (e.g. Uniform, Books etc.)

b. Number of scholarships:

1. Scholarship for low economic background

Under this scheme, two (2) eligible students (male / female student) based on their family income and merit shall be entitled for the scholarship. To avail the scholarship, candidates are required to produce proof of family income or any other document as mandated by MBIL.

2. Scholarship for female student

Under this scheme, one (1) female student based on merit & irrespective of her family income shall be entitled for the scholarship.

However, this year Mercedes Benz India has proposed to offer scholarship to all female candidates securing admission to the course. The confirmation from MBIL is still awaited.

3. Mercedes Benz India reserves the rights to either withdraw the scholarship or change the criteria.

9 SEAT ALLOCATION & RESERVATION

The annual batch size / intake capacity is 20 students. Five seats shall be reserved for MBIL dealer nominees, sponsored and approved by MBIL. Remaining seats shall be open for the candidates based on merit in the entrance examination. **Passing of entrance examination shall be mandatory for all categories (both sponsored & non-sponsored) of candidates.** Common merit list will be prepared on the basis of entrance examination. Reservation criteria as per the approved government policy will be adopted for Non-sponsored seats. However, in case qualified candidates are not available for admission in any reserved category, the seats will be de-reserved as per reservation policy of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

The reservations in various categories shall be as follows: -

SC Category: 15% seats of non-sponsored seats / intake for fresh admission are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste.

ST Category: 7.5% seats of non-sponsored seats / intake for fresh admission are reserved for candidate belonging to Scheduled Tribe.

OBC Category: 27% seats of non-sponsored seats / intake for fresh admission are reserved for **OBC** candidates belonging to **NONCREAMY LAYER**.

NOTE 1:

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Castes /Scheduled Tribes /OBCs, the candidate should produce a certificate, in original, at the time of admission issued by approved competent authority, indicating the Scheduled Caste /Tribe /OBC (Non creamy layer) to which the candidate belongs.

A list of approved authorities is given below:

- (i) District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Deputy Commissioner / Collector / Additional Deputy Commissioner / Deputy Collector / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate.
- (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (iv) Administrator / Secretary to Administrator / Development Officer (Lakshadweep & Minicoy Island).

NOTE 2:

- a) Caste certificate in the name of the applicant from competent authority is to be submitted at the time of admission, failing which the candidate / candidature will be considered under general category. In case of certificate in father's name, admissions will be provisional. The candidate will have to produce caste certificate in his / her name within three months from the date of provisional admission.
- b) **Reserved category, once indicated in the application form, cannot be changed at the time of counseling / admission.**
- c) **The creamy layer amongst OBC's has been excluded from benefit of reservation.**
- d) For availing reservation under OBC category candidate is required to bring OBC certificate from competent authority clearly indicating that he / she belongs to non – creamy layer. Statement on Family income for the previous year from all sources should also be available in the certificate. The OBC (Non Creamy Layer) certificate is to be issued on or after 1st August, 2018. If it is issued prior to 01-08-2018, then it should be accompanied with a valid family Income certificate issued on or after 01-08-2018 from the competent authority mentioned in the list of approved authorities.

NOTE 3:

The policy of admission to foreign nationals shall be made available in website <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in> in due course, if required.

Additional Information Regarding Reservation

1. Reservation of seats will be as per the policy of the Govt. and will be subject to any change / amendment made by the Government.
2. Any unfilled seat reserved for Scheduled Castes will be treated as reserved for Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa. The seats will be de-reserved for General Category only after exhausting the complete list of SC / ST candidates (The de-reservation shall be considered after the first round of counseling).
3. Any seat under reserved category remaining unfilled will be transferred to General Category.
4. Benefit of reservation shall be available only if the category to which a candidate belongs to is mentioned in the original application form. If nothing is indicated by the candidate in the application form, the candidate will be treated in **General category**.

10 AAEE APPLICATION FORM

a. Information Bulletin

b. AAEE Application Form

Candidates are advised to read information bulletin carefully and acquaint themselves with all requirements before filling up application form.

The application form can be downloaded from <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in> from 15-05-2019.

No column in the application form should be left blank. If any column is not applicable, write N.A. in the respective column. Application form should be clearly, legibly filled with black ball point pen or neatly typed. The signature of the candidate should be made with BLACK BALL POINT PEN ONLY.

Candidates have to send a single clear PDF file, containing duly filled in & signed application form along with proof of examination fee paid (online) & any one of the valid Photo Id proof (issued by Government of India viz. Passport, PAN card, Aadhar Card, Driving License, EPIC / voter identity card), BEFORE LAST / CLOSING DATE (09-06-2019) OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FORM to the e-mail ID aaee@gbpit-amrc.ac.in However, note that the last date for payment of examination fee online is 08-06-2019. Application forms sent by post / courier / by hand / special messenger or any other mode will NOT BE ACCEPTED

c. Guidelines for Filling-Up the Application Form for AAEE

- a. Candidates are advised to read information bulletin carefully and acquaint themselves with all requirements before filling up application form for AAEE 2019.**
- b. It will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to make sure that he/she is eligible to apply and fulfills all the conditions prescribed for the admission.**
- c. The application form should be filled in English only.**
- d. Incomplete application forms will be summarily rejected.**
- e. The candidate should write his/her name and the father's name in capital letters as given in **Secondary School Certificate of the Board or the University.****
- f. Before filling-in the application form, it is advisable to write the name and other particulars on a separate sheet of paper first to verify the correctness of spellings.**
- g. Write the required information in capital letters with a black ball point pen in the boxes (wherever provided, e.g Name of the candidate, Mother's Name & Occupation, Father's / Guardian's Name & Occupation etc)**
- h. Select / tick mark any one if options are given (e. g. Govt. of India issued ID card detail, category)**

- i. Candidate shall fill-in the application form giving all the required particulars **except the space meant for Office Use**, using **black ballpoint pen** in the prescribed boxes (wherever provided). Village, Post Office, Tehsil and District can be abbreviated as Vill., P.O., Tehsil and Distt., respectively. **Pin code number, Phone number, Mobile No. and e-mail address** must be given in the space provided for the purpose.
- j. PHOTOGRAPH OF THE CANDIDATE: The candidate should affix his / her recent Passport size colour photograph (without attestation). **The photograph should be pasted and NOT STAPLED within the space** marked for it. *Instructions for Photograph: The photograph should not have cap, goggles etc. (Spectacles are allowed). The photo should not be hazy. It should clearly cover at least 75% of the face of the candidate.* The candidate should keep at least five identical Photographs with him/her. One photograph should be pasted on the application form and rest will be required at the time of counselling (if eligible).

Note: Admission of the student shall stand cancelled ab-initio, if any information supplied or document submitted is proved to be false/ fake at any stage during admission process / even after admission.

11 SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

Steps:

- a. **Pay examination fee of Rs. 500/-** (Rupees Five Hundred only) for General & OBC candidates including sponsored candidates and Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred & Fifty Only) for SC/ST applicants, online to Automotive Mechatronics Research Centre- AMRC account number: 37652460699 IFSC : SBIN0000727. Take print out of the 'details of transaction / fee submission' or save the transaction details. Note down the transaction identity or reference number of transaction (to be filled at column No.4 "FEE DETAILS" in the application form)
- b. **Fill all particulars (front and back side) in the application form and put full signature.**
- c. Keep ready any one of the **valid Photo Id proof issued by Government of India** viz. Passport, PAN card, Aadhar Card, Driving License, EPIC / voter identity card
- d. **Scan all the three documents (as detailed in steps a, b, c i.e. duly filled in application form, proof of examination fee paid & valid Photo Id proof issued by Govt. of India). The image is to be very clear and legible as it will be used**

for processing the application form for examination and for securing admission.

- e. Create a SINGLE Portable Document Format (PDF) file with all the three documents
- f. Rename the file with candidates name and date of birth (e. g: If candidate's name is H.Sahana and date of birth is 18-02-1996, then PDF file name is to be 'hsahana18021996')
- g. Login to your e-mail ID (you have to use the same e-mail ID which you have mentioned / written at Column No. 1. (k) in the application form)
- h. Attach the Portable Document Format (PDF) file created and in Subject write Application Form for AAEE -2019
- i. Send the e-mail to aae@gbpit-amrc.ac.in **before closing date of receipt of application form i. e 09-06-2019. Please note that the last date for online payment of examination fee is 08-06-2019.**
- j. **Any other mode, including offline mode i. e Application forms sent by post / courier / by hand / special messenger, will NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

NOTE : (1) All the three scanned documents viz, duly filled application form, proof of fee paid (online) & Government of India issued identity proof are to be sent as a 'single file' in Portable Document Format (in PDF) to the AAEE ID aae@gbpit-amrc.ac.in
(2) Ensure your e-mail ID is active at least till completion of admission process.

12 ADMIT CARD AND EXAMINATION CENTRE

a. Admit Card

- a. The candidates are required to carry the same identity proof, IN ORIGINAL, which has been scanned and sent through e-mail, along with application form & proof of exam fee paid.
- b. The list of eligible candidates for appearing AAEE will be displayed in the website of AMRC / ADAM i. e <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in> after closing date of receipt of application form. Only such eligible candidates who are allotted with enrolment / roll number (as published on the GBPIT & AMRC / ADAM website) will be eligible for appearing in ADAM Admission Entrance Examination – 2019 (AAEE - 2019).
- c. **No separate admit card / hall ticket** will be issued.

b. Examination Centre

G B Pant Institute of Technology shall be functioning as nodal agency as well as the main examination centre for conducting All India ADAM Admission Entrance

Examination (A A E E). **The AAE Examination is to be held in Delhi.** However, examination centres other than Delhi may be considered, if required.

Final allotment of examination centre to a candidate will be decided by G B Pant Institute of Technology. Request for change of examination centre will not be entertained on any account.

It will be the sole responsibility of candidates themselves to make sure that they have noted / collected correct details of the examination centers from the website. The GBPIT shall not be responsible for any kind of consequences faced by the candidate on account of any mistake committed by him / her in collecting the information about the examination centers.

13 MODE OF ADAM ADMISSION ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (AAEE)

I. Scheme of the Examination

a. Theory Examination

- (I) The AAEE will comprise of objective type questions from the areas of Basics of Electrical Engg, Basics of Electronics Engg, Basics of Automobile Engg, Basics of Mechanical Engg, Physics, English language, Numerical Ability, Analytical Reasoning, General Knowledge & Current affairs. Equal weightage shall be given to each section of the areas identified. The Question paper shall consist of multiple choice questions having four options. The candidates are required to mark their answers using black ball point pen only.
- (II) The Theory Examination Question Booklet will contain 100 objective-type questions. Each question will be provided with four alternative options (A,B,C,D). Out of the given four options, **only one option**, which is most appropriate, is to be chosen as answer and its option number is to be written (Use CAPITAL letter / UPPER CASE) on the answer sheet against the respective serial number of the question, using **black ball point pen only**.
- (III) Each question shall carry one (01) mark. There is no negative marking.
- (IV) **Theory Examination will be of ninety minutes duration and will carry 100 marks.**
- (V) The medium / language of the question papers for the examination will be English.
- (VI) No writer to the candidate shall be permitted under any circumstances.
- (VII) No requests for re-checking, re-evaluation, re-assessment or scrutiny of answer-scripts will be entertained.

b. Practical Test / Skill Test / Personal interview

The candidates are also required to appear for the Practical / Skill Test / Personal Interview, in continuation to theory examination. Practical / Skill Test / Personal Interview may continue on the next day / date of theory examination, if required. Isometric, orthographic projections & its symbols, Measurements using Vernier caliper, Measurements using Multi-meter, Identifying various components etc., shall be the brief content of the practical / skill test. However, Schedule for Practical test/Skill test/Personal Interview shall be notified along with the list of eligible candidates, on the website <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in>

c. The Answer Sheet – Theory Examination

- i) The answer-sheet will be supplied at the examination centre along with the question booklet.
- ii) A specimen copy of answer-sheet, is enclosed as ANNEXURE IV.
- iii) Candidates are advised to go through it and be conversant with the requirements of mentioning the required particulars and indicating the answers so that they can comply the same during the Examination without any mistake and avoidable loss of time.
- iv) The two sides of the answer sheet are to be used as follows:
 - a) **Side 1:** This side of the answer sheet contains the following columns which are to be filled - in with a **black ball point pen** only, neatly and accurately: -
 - i) Candidate's name (In capital letters)
 - ii) Enrollment Number.
 - b) **Side 2:** This side of the answer sheet contains the following columns, which are to be filled - with **black ball point pen** only: -
 - i) Mother's Name
 - ii) Father's / Guardian's Name (In capital letters)
 - iii) Date of Birth
 - iv) Gender
 - v) Govt. of India issued ID card number
 - vi) Name of Examination Centre
 - vii) Place and date
 - viii) Signature of the candidate

The Examination Question Booklet will contain 100 objective-type questions. Each question will be provided with four alternative options (A,B,C,D). Out of the given four

options, **only one option**, which is most appropriate, is to be chosen as answer and it is to be written in CAPITAL LETTERS / UPPER CASE (A,B,C,D) on the answer sheet against the respective serial number of the question, using **black ball point pen only**.

Candidates should not make any marks or write any other kind of description on the answer sheet, other than specified above. Candidates should not do any rough work on the answer-sheet. Rough work, if any, is to be done in the Examination Question Booklet only.

II. Procedure to be followed in the Theory Examination Hall

- i) Candidates are advised to reach examination centre **at least 45 minutes** before commencement of examination.
- ii) Ten minutes before the commencement of the exam, each candidate will be given answer sheet. Immediately on receipt of the answer sheet, each candidate is expected to fill the required particulars with a black ballpoint pen only. Candidate will also read instructions given on the **cover page of Exam Question Booklet**.
- iii) Five minutes before the commencement of the Examination, the candidate will be supplied with Examination Question Booklet. Candidates are required to fill the name and enrolment number in the question booklet also. Read the instructions given in the **exam question booklet carefully**.
- iv) Communication in any manner inside the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
- v) Candidates will then write the required particulars on SIDE – 1 and SIDE – 2 of the answer-sheet with a **black ballpoint pen** as already explained. After this, the candidates will wait for the signal by the invigilator to start marking the responses.
- vi) **The examination will start at 10:00 AM** and an announcement to this effect will be made by the invigilator.
- vii) While the exam is in progress, the invigilator will check the identity of the candidates and get their signature in attendance sheet and answer sheet to satisfy, himself / herself about the identity of each candidate. The invigilator will also put his/her signature in the place provided for the purpose in the answer-sheet.
- viii) After completing the examination and before handing over the answer sheet to the invigilator, the candidates are again advised to make sure that all the particulars required to be filled in the answer sheet, (particularly the Enrolment No), have been correctly written.

- ix) A signal will be given at the beginning of the exam and at half time. A signal will also be given at the closing time when the candidate must stop marking the responses and handover the Answer Sheet to the Invigilator in the exam room/hall.

III. Other Important Information

- i) Candidates are advised to reach examination centre at least 45 minutes before commencement of examination.
- ii) **Candidates reporting after the commencement of the examination shall not be permitted to appear in AAE examination.**
- iii) **The theory examination will start at 10:00 AM and practical / skill test / interview at 01:00 PM.**
- iv) **The practical / skill test / interview may continue on the next day / date of theory examination, if required. Hence, candidates are advised to be prepared for the same. However, Schedule for Practical test/Skill test/Personal Interview shall be notified along with the list of eligible candidates, on the website <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in>.**
- v) Candidates shall not be allowed to carry inside the examination hall any textual material, printed or written, bits of paper or any other material of similar nature except the Government of India issued identity card.
- vi) Calculators, log tables, electronic watches with facilities for calculation, cellular phones, pagers and other materials of similar nature shall not be allowed inside the examination hall. No arrangement for the safe custody of any of these items will be made at the examination centre; the centre in-charge or his office will not be responsible for loss of any such items.
- vii) No candidate, without the permission of the Centre Superintendent or the Invigilator concerned, will leave his/her seat or the examination hall.
- viii) **Candidates shall NOT be permitted to leave the theory examination hall and practical / skill test / interview centre before completion of Theory Examination & practical / skill test / interview. Candidates shall not leave the examination hall without handing over the answer-sheet & / or skill test assessment sheet to the Invigilator on duty.**
- ix) Smoking in the examination hall during the conduct of the exam is strictly prohibited.
- x) Tea, coffee, cold drinks or snacks are not allowed to be taken inside the examination hall.
- xi) Candidates shall maintain perfect silence. Any conversation or disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed to be an act of misbehavior / misconduct. The

act of misbehavior / malpractice / unfair means / impersonation in the AAEE will lead to the cancellation of candidature. He / She will be debarred from taking AAEE, in addition to any other action as deemed fit, under the Indian Penal Code.

- xii) Only the result of the entrance exam shall not entitle a candidate to get admission in Advanced Diploma in Automotive Mechatronics (ADAM). The candidates have to fulfill eligibility conditions of the relevant qualifying examination & all other relevant conditions, as applicable.
- xiii) At any stage, if it is found that the candidate has furnished any false or incorrect information in the application form, his/her candidature for the course will be cancelled.
- xiv) It will also be the sole responsibility of the candidates themselves to make sure that they are eligible and fulfill all other conditions prescribed for admission before applying for admission.
- xv) The eligibility of the candidates for admission to ADAM course shall be verified at the time of counselling.

A candidate must bring his / her black ballpoint pen. Pencil should not to be used.

14 MERIT LIST

- (I) Based on the marks obtained in the entrance examination (i.e. both Theory & Practical / skill / personal interview), a list of candidates in order of merit shall be prepared. For being eligible for admission, a General category candidate must secure a minimum of 40% marks, and reserved category (SC /ST / OBC /PH) must secure a minimum of 20% marks in AAEE. The candidates belonging to reserved category, who qualifies on the basis of relaxation in cut off percentage, i.e., 20%, will not be eligible for admission against General category seats. **However, if required, final cut off marks in each category shall be decided by GBPIT.**
- (II) The inter-se merit of candidates securing equal aggregate marks at the entrance exam will be determined as below :
Candidates securing more marks in other engineering section of question paper [i. e candidate having qualified from Electrical Engg discipline (or analogous discipline) scoring more marks in Mechanical section of question paper and vice versa in AAEE, shall rank higher].
In case of a further tie, the rank would be based on marks obtained in Practical Examination / skill test / interview; then, the order of rank would be based on marks obtained in Physics in AAEE- 2019, followed by marks obtained in Test of English

Language, marks obtained in Numerical Ability followed by Analytical reasoning, General Knowledge & Current affairs and then the Date of birth (the candidate older in age shall rank higher) for drawing the merit list.

15 DECLARATION OF RESULT

The office of Controller-AAEE **shall declare the inter-se rank of qualified candidates only. No separate intimation shall be sent to the candidates in this regard.** The result of the ADAM Admission Entrance Examination will be displayed on **01-07-2019** by **4.00 P.M.** on the website <http://www.gbpit-amrc.ac.in>

However, a separate merit list shall also be prepared for MBIL dealer nominees, sponsored and approved by MBIL.

16 COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

17 POST ADMISSION INFORMATION

a. Cancellation of Admission & Refund of Admission / Course Fee

The course / admission fee once paid will not be refunded. However, (a) if a candidate withdraws candidature during the process of admission & another / next eligible candidate is equipped to secure admission, the refund of course / admission fee, shall be considered (b) if a candidate withdraws candidature after commencement of course and

within 15 days of its commencement & another next eligible candidate is equipped to secure admission, the refund of course / admission fee, shall be considered.

Course / admission fee will not be refunded, after 15 days from commencement of course.

b. Dues and Penalties

At the end of each module trainees will be appearing for Module Examination, which will be conducted by AMRC / GBPIT. All theory exams and continuous evaluation sheets (Term work) will be evaluated by ADAM Trainers of AMRC / GBPIT. **Final Practical Examination will be conducted by Mercedes- Benz Academy Assessor.**

Final practical exam shall comprise of 50% marks for work plan preparation and 50% marks for job execution. Passing marks against each examination head shall be 50%

f. Re- assessment

If a trainee / student could not perform in the final practical assessment or failed to full-fill the requirements to be qualified in the practical exam, re- assessment will be conducted.

All re- assessments shall happen at Mercedes- Benz Academy, Pune or at the discretion of Mercedes Benz India.
